## **MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (REGISTRATION) (GENERAL PROVISIONS) (COVID-19 – TEMPORARY AMENDMENTS) (JERSEY) ORDER 2020**

*Made* 25th March 2020  
*Coming into force* 26th March 2020

**THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES** makes this Order under Articles 5, 5A(1) and 12A of the Medical Practitioners (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1960<sup>1</sup> –

### **1 Amendment of the Medical Practitioners (Registration) (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 2014**

After Article 9 of the Medical Practitioners (Registration) (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 2014<sup>2</sup> there is inserted –

#### **“9A Modifications due to outbreak of Covid-19**

- (1) Where the Minister has informed the Commission that an emergency exists in Jersey due to the outbreak of Covid-19, this Order has effect with the modifications in paragraph (2) for the period of the emergency.
- (2) The modifications are –
  - (a) Article 4(1) has effect as if –
    - (i) in sub-paragraph (b) after “the Schedule” there is inserted “unless the Commission does not consider it reasonable in the circumstances to require those particulars and documents”;
    - (ii) sub-paragraph (d) is deleted;
  - (b) Article 5(a) has effect as if after “section 3” there is inserted “or 18A”.
- (3) This Article expires on 30th September 2020.”.

**2 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Registration) (General Provisions) (Covid-19 – Temporary Amendments) (Jersey) Order 2020 and comes into force the day after it is made.
