<p>**If a provider is registered after 31st March in any year the annual fee payable is as follows –</p> <p>(a) where the application is received between 1st April and 30th June, 75% of the fee otherwise payable but for this paragraph;</p> <p>(b) where the application is received between 1st July and 30th September, 50% of the fee otherwise payable but for this paragraph; and</p> <p>(c) where the application is received between 1st October and 31st December, 25% of the fee otherwise payable but for this paragraph.</p>
