

Guidance for Registering a Piercing and Tattooing Premises

Registration is governed by the Piercing and Tattooing (Jersey) Law 2002 ([Piercing and Tattooing \(Jersey\) Law 2002 \(jerseylaw.je\)](#))

The Law regulates the following treatments which are defined in the approved code of practice ([Code-of-Practice-Piercing-and-Tattooing.pdf \(carecommission.je\)](#)):

Acupuncture (including Dry Needling)

Body Piercing

Ear piercing

Electrolysis

Tattooing (including Semi Permanent Make-Up)

Any premise where the above treatments are administered must be registered and the applicant must agree to comply with the approved code of practice.

To apply for registration, please complete and sign the application form ([E-ApplicationPremisesRegistrationPT-2022.08.05.doc \(live.com\)](#)) and send it scanned to notifications@carecommission.je or by mail, together with:

- the fee of £100.00 (payment details are detailed on the form)

Once the form is received, an inspector will arrange a pre-registration visit to ensure that the premises complies with the requirements that are detailed in the approved code of practice.

All persons administering the treatments in a registered practice must be registered as a practitioner under the law, or be registered in an exempt profession. A list of the exempt professions is given in the approved code of practice.
