<p><b>small provider of a charity care home service</b> means a provider</p> <p>(a) that is a registered charity defined in the Charities (Jersey) Law 2014;</p> <p>(b) that has no more than 10 beds in total available for use as part of the care home service;</p> <p>(c) whose sole activity is the provision of a care home service;</p> <p>(d) that charges fees to its service users that are no more than the fees that would be charged for long-term care services under the Long Term Care (Health and Social Services Charges) (Jersey) Law 2014 for each such service user;</p> <p>(e) that does not charge its service users for any supplementary or top up services; and</p> <p>(f) that does not hold any contract for services with, nor receives any form of grant or aid from, any administration of the States of Jersey.</p>

<p><b>In relation to a children and family community nursing service:</b></p> <p><b>Small provider</b> means a provider that provides an aggregate amount of care to all its service users of no more than 112 hours in any week;  <b>Medium provider</b> means a provider that provides an aggregate amount of care to all its service users of more than 112 hours but not more than 600 hours in any week;  <b>Medium plus provider</b> means a provider that provides an aggregate amount of care to all its service users of more than 600 hours but not more than 2,250 hours in any week;  <b>Large provider</b> means a provider that provides an aggregate amount of care to all its service users of more than 2,250 hours in any week.</p>			
<p><b>**If a provider is registered after 31st March in any year the annual fee payable is as follows –</b></p> <p>(a) where the application is received between 1st April and 30th June, 75% of the fee otherwise payable but for this paragraph;</p> <p>(b) where the application is received between 1st July and 30th September, 50% of the fee otherwise payable but for this paragraph; and</p> <p>(c) where the application is received between 1st October and 31st December, 25% of the fee otherwise payable but for this paragraph.</p>
